

GENDER ROLE STUDY

In 2007, Sycamore View entrusted our shepherds and ministers to address three areas requiring additional clarity as our church moved forward with our mission of *helping people see Jesus*. The three areas were *divorce and remarriage, instrumental worship, and the role of women in our worship assemblies*. As our church prayerfully moved through these first two areas, we arrived at a point where we believed our understanding was faithful to Scripture.

Over a year ago, the shepherds and ministers began exploring the final area—the role of women in our worship assemblies. Through a variety of settings, we have studied, prayed, fasted, and sought wisdom from other churches that have also reconsidered this important issue. The study has been an exciting, challenging, and sometimes uncomfortable process as any deep, objective study of God's word often becomes.

After a year of study and exploration, we want to share with and lead you in this study of women's roles in worship assemblies. As we explore this issue, we want to include the entire Sycamore View family in this journey. Our desire is to walk along with you and lead you in some of the studies, discussions, and conversations in which we have been actively involved.

The intention is to study and interact in several ways throughout the month of June. During this time, we will have Bible classes led by shepherds and Josh will deliver three engaging lessons on this study. We will also offer several "listening sessions" to help provide a smaller group setting in which to interact with shepherds, ministers and other members of our family on this topic.

As a leadership team dedicated to the feeding, leading, and caring for our church body, our shepherds and ministers ask that you please join us on this journey with open hearts and minds.
