What is Camp?

Sycamore View Youth Camp is an opportunity for children and teens to experience God, grow spiritually, make life-long friends, and create unforgettable memories! Going to Camp means late nights laughing with friends in your cabins, inspirational times of worship, getting to know amazing adult counselors, heating up playing sports, cooling off in the pool, creating masterpieces in the Craft Shack, daily doses of ice cream and icees, and so much more. Sycamore View rents the Rose of Sharon Camp in Tipton County each summer for our week of camp.

Dates to Know:

April 28 | Registration Deadline (\$50 Deposit required)

June 16 | Balance Due

June 30 | Camp begins (7 p.m.)

July 5 | Camp ends (3 p.m.)

Accommodations & Food:

Campers stay in cabins with air conditioning and bathroom facilities in each cabin. Campers are divided according to age and gender. Each cabin has multiple adult counselors who are volunteering their time to serve at camp. Counselors are parents and other caring adults who are connected to the Sycamore View Church, have passed a background check, and attended volunteer equipping sessions. Three meals a day are provided in the dining hall. In addition, the Snack Shack is open twice a day for campers to buy additional food. Campers are welcome to pack their own snacks.

Transportation:

Campers provide their own transportation to and from SV Youth Camp @ Rose of Sharon Camp. If campers are old enough to drive and bring their vehicles to camp, they will be asked to let their counselor keep their keys during the week.

Fees:

The registration fee of \$240 covers lodging, meals, all activities, and a t-shirt. Additional money (suggested at least \$40) will be needed for the Snack Shack. The Craft Shack will be free this year! Any camper sent home due to disciplinary reasons would not receive a refund. For campers who cannot attend the entire camp session, a prorated rate of \$50 per day will apply.

Registered campers will receive an email in mid-June with detailed information, a what-to-bring list, and a Camper Medical Form that will need to be completed.
